We are happy to submit our Second annual report of Regenboog India Foundation!!!

It was another great year for us after the first successful year of the organization, the small sapling (small tree) planted last year growing fast as big tree and started giving support to the beneficiaries in this year. It was possible because of good cooperation and motivation from donors, sponsors, staff, beneficiaries, government officials and volunteers.

**General:**

We have received the 12A registration and 80G registrations from Income Tax departments for Regenboog India Foundation. Also we have applied FCRA prior permission to receive foreign contributions for our rural health care project and children home project from Holland and we have received the permission in October 2007.

**Sarasvathi Children Home:**

All our seven kids were had a nice time with good care and love. During this year Sarasvathi Children Home family have grownup by adding another eight more kids to it. So now we have fifteen kids totally in the family of Sarasvathi children home.

Nine kids were admitted in a local English medium school and six kids were admitted in a local government Tamil medium primary school in VEDIYAPPANUR village itself. They all got a proper coaching in the evening at home by our house mother and care taker.

During the year we have celebrated all functions in our children home. Children were gone to their native places for Pongal festival. In general all children are having normal health condition.

**Arunachala Village Medical Program:**

From January onwards we have started giving medical treatment to five different centers, which is covering the population of around 43,000 people in Chengam block. We are giving our service to the people in and around of Melapunjai, Melkuppam, Padi Agraharam, Kilayur villages. A well qualified doctor, a nurse, a pharmacist and volunteers team visited these villages and given treatment to the patients. During 2007-08 period, we have treated totally 13,419 patients. In this year the team visited every Monday, Tuesday, Wednesdays, Thursday and Saturdays to these villages. So the average patient count per day is 112.

**Conclusion:**

Since from the last two financial years, we have started serving the needy society on the right way. Still it is a long road and the journey going through its aim of serving with good care and love to all. We are sure that during the journey, Regenboog will establish many strong landmarks and achievements for these good causes.
